



Tumbeta House



Welcome to Tumbeta House on Djuma Private Game Reserve. Located in the northern section of the Sabi Sands reserve that forms part of the Greater Kruger National Park, this is one of South Africa's premier Big Five safari destinations.

Djuma is world-renowned for its epic wildlife encounters and thrilling game viewing and has become a safari legend with a legacy stretching back to the early 1990s, when Jurie and Pippa Moolman first opened their family farm for business.

Tumbeta House is the newest lodge at Djuma, having opened in February 2020. It is the former home of Jurie's sister, Inga Moolman, and has been lovingly refurbished to offer the ultimate African safari retreat, accommodating just six people – making it ideal for small groups of friends or families.

Located a short drive from the main Djuma compound and set in its own, fully fenced compound, Tumbeta House is surrounded by landscaped gardens and overlooks a small waterhole. It's completely surrounded by one of the best game-viewing areas in South Africa and has been designed as an homage to the "real" Africa and the spirit of this incredible part of the Greater Kruger ecosystem.

A stay at Tumbeta House gives guests the chance to immerse themselves completely in the wilderness, viewing game at close quarters without having to leave the lodge. Intimate and secluded, it encourages guests to switch off from the outside world and experience authentic Africa at its finest, adjusting to the rhythm of the bush while appreciating the privilege of being in such a truly special place.

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A sparkling swimming pool beckons in the heat of the day and a raised viewing deck looks out over an adjacent waterhole, which can also be viewed from a different perspective inside the eye-level hide. A sleep-out deck affords guests the chance to sleep outside, on mattresses under mosquito nets – an experience not to be missed!

The main house is an open plan living space and features a large cottage-style kitchen and scullery area, dining and living areas and an open fireplace for cooler nights. It opens out onto the verandah on three sides and overlooks the swimming pool and waterhole beyond the fence.

The guest rooms are a combination of simplicity and elegance, with the usual Djuma homage to African culture and art thanks to Pippa Moolman's incredible artistic talent and sharp eye for design.

Like all of Djuma's accommodation options, Tumbeta House is available on a self-catering basis with the services of professionally trained and experienced chefs, safari guides and trackers included in the exclusive-use rate for a minimum stay of three nights. Guests bring their own food and drink for the duration of their stay and our chef will prepare meals as and when required.



Rates

Rates are for exclusive use of Tumbeta House on a self-catering basis. The rate is for the entire lodge, sleeping a maximum of six guests, for a minimum three-night stay. Guests are required to bring their own food and drinks for the duration of their stay. The services of a chef are included in the rate, as are all game viewing activities.
